

## Dong Jin Suh



Dong Jin Suh is the Director of vievis NAMUH Hospital in Seoul and Adjunct Professor of Hepatology, Asan Medical Center, University of Ulsan, Korea. He was the Director of Internal Medicine as well as Department of Gastroenterology and also the vice-Dean of College of Medicine, University of Ulsan. He graduated from the College of Medicine, Seoul National University and subsequently obtained his PhD in Medical Sciences from the same university. He completed a research fellowship in Liver Unit, King's College Hospital, London , U.K.

He is a current member of Korean association for the study of Liver (KASL) , the Korean Society of Gastroenterology(KSG) and Asian Pacific Association for the Study of the Liver(APASL). He was the President of the KASL(2005-2006) and the KSG(2007). He also held the position of President of the 18<sup>th</sup> Conference of APASL in Seoul in 2008. He is currently the President of Korean Liver Foundation.

Professor Suh's research interest lies in the treatment strategies for liver diseases, focusing on HBV and HCV. He has written over 250 journal articles and coordinated clinical trials involving hepatitis B and HCC.
