

Leon Adams Biography

Leon Adams (MBBS, FRACP, PhD) is an Associate Professor in the Medical School of the University of Western Australia and Consultant Hepatologist in the Liver Transplant Unit at Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital (Perth, Western Australia).

A/Prof Adams completed his PhD in 2006 (University of Western Australia) and has spent fellowships at Mayo Clinic and the University of California, San Diego. His research interests focus on translational, clinical and epidemiological aspects of nonalcoholic fatty liver disease in which he has published over 120 articles with over 7500 citations.

He is currently on the editorial board of Hepatology and the Journal of Gastroenterology and Hepatology and has served on numerous committee's and faculties of the Australian Liver Association, the Gastroenterology Society of Australia, the National Health and Medical Research Council and is a member of the NAFLD Special Interest Group committee and Act-First educational faculty within the AASLD.
