

QIN NING, MD, Ph.D



Dr. Qin Ning is a Professor in Hepatology and Clinical Immunology. She is the chair of the institute & Department of Infectious Diseases in Tongji Hospital, Tongji Medical College, Huazhong University of Science and Technology. Dr. NING obtained her MD in 1985 and PhD in 1993 from Tongji Medical School, and had her postdoctoral training and research experience from 1994 to 2000 in University of Toronto. She then subsequently appointed as the full professor in 2000 and the department chair since 2006 in Tongji hospital. She has been appointed as the chief scientist of 973 projects in viral hepatitis and liver failure study from Ministry of Science and Technology of China in 2007. She is also the Principal Investigator on National twelfth/thirteenth “five years” project in Science and Technology, and the ministry of education innovation team development plan.

Dr. Ning’s clinical care activities include hepatology, clinical immunology, and infectious disease, with focus on viral hepatitis. Since 2008, she serves as the leadership for national multicenter clinical studies for hepatitis B (Switch study OSST and combination study Endeavor /Anchor). Her research interests are pathogenesis and molecular mechanisms of viral hepatitis (especially antiviral therapy and immune regulation, severe hepatitis, liver failure) and autoimmune liver disease, liver cancer and gene therapy, etc. She has been funded and awarded the National Science Fund for Distinguished Young Scholar, the Ministry of Education, and the Ministry of Science and Technology of China. Dr. Ning has published over 300 peer reviewed articles (223 SCI publications), including J Clin Invest, Journal of Hepatology, J Biol Chem, J Immunol, Human Gene Therapy, Hepatology International, Liver International, etc. These works have been cited by SCI papers for more than 1847 times so far. She also served as editors or reviewers for Liver International, Human Gene Therapy, Antiviral Research, Journal of Gastroenterology and Hepatology, Journal of Hepatology, et al.

Dr. Ning is a Vice President of Society of Infectious Disease, Chinese Medical Association and Vice President of Society of Infection Control, Chinese Preventive Medicine Association. Since 2013, she has served as the President of Society of Infectious Disease, Medical Association of Hubei Province and Vice President of Society of the Liver Study of Liver, Medical Association of Hubei Province.
