

Brief Curriculum Vitae of Professor Salimur Rahman

Professor Salimur Rahman is a eminent Hepatologist of Bangladesh and at present working as Professor of Hepatology & Course Director, Faculty of Medicine, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University which is the pioneer medical university of the country. He is one of the founders of the discipline in the country.

He is a co-editor of 1) 'Liver: A Complete Book on Hepato-Pancreato-Biliary Diseases' and 2) 'Comprehensive Text Book of Hepatitis B' published by Elsevier and Jaypee respectively. Professor Rahman has over 100 publications in international and regional journals. He is Editor-in-Chief of Euroasian Journal of Hepato-Gastroenterology, the official publication of Euroasian Gastroenterological Association and Viral Hepatitis Foundation Bangladesh. He is the Member of the Editorial Board of Hepatology International, Official Journal of the Asian Pacific Association for the Study of the Liver (APASL).

He is the current President of Association for the Study of the Liver Diseases, Bangladesh – the National Association of Hepatologists of the country and the immediate past-President of Association of Physicians of Bangladesh – the premier platform of specialist physicians of Bangladesh. He is also the founder Chairman of Viral Hepatitis Foundation Bangladesh. He has served as member of the National committee for Hepatitis B virus in Bangladesh and also served as executive committee member of Asian Pacific Association for the study of the Liver (APASL). He is the immediate past President of South Asian Association for the Study of Liver (SAASL).

Professor Salimur Rahman is a leading interventional hepatologist of the country and has pioneered the transformation of Hepatology from a theoretical to an interventional super-specialty in this country. He is at present he senior most and a founder faculty member of the Department of Hepatology, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University. He is a Fellow of Bangladesh College of Physicians and Surgeons, Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh and Royal College of Physicians of Ireland.

His research interests include viral hepatitis B & C, hepatocellular carcinoma and Hydatid disease of liver.

He has delivered lectures in many national and International forum on different aspects of liver diseases including Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and Hepatocellular carcinoma. He has the experience of presiding many scientific sessions in the national and International liver conference.
