Prof. Wasim Jafri is a very well-known Hepato1ogist/Gastroenterologist in Pakistan and he has earned a great name not only in Pakistan but in the Asian-Pacific region. After obtaining his initial training in medicine and gastroenterology in the United Kingdom (UK) he was trained in Hepatology at the University of Miami, Florida working with Dr. Eugene Schiff. He introduced the modern science of gastroenterology and Hepatology in Pakistan when he returned back in 1987 and since then he is at the Aga Khan University in Karachi Pakistan. He developed the specialty of gastroenterology and Hepatology at the Aga Khan university hospital and became the founding associate dean and chair of the department of continuing professional education. Prof. Jafri has been a Member of the Royal College of Surgeons, Member of the Royal College of Physicians United Kingdom, Fellow of the Royal Colleges of Physicians of London, Edinburgh and Glasgow, Fellow of the American College of Physicians and Fellow of the American College of Gastroenterology. He became fellow of the foundation of the international medical education and research (FAIMER) institute in 2002 by completing 2 years fellowship . He was also the Governor of the American College of Gastroenterology for Pakistan from 2012-2015. Dr Jafri is director of the World Gastroenterology Organization Karachi training center for over 15 years. At the Aga Khan University he has been recipient of the outstanding teacher's award. He had been Chair of Medicine and the Head of Gastroenterology and Hepatology and is currently heading the Department for Continuing Professional Education (DCPE) along with his clinical and other responsibilities. Prof. Jafri has over 250 peer reviewed publications in gastroenterology and Hepatology with over 7800 citations which are referenced in national and international journals. He has published several book chapters as well. At the AASLD, Prof. Jafri is a member since 2001 and has been supporting the special interest group of HBV, HCV, HCC, Portal hypertension and Fatty liver disease. He was recently awarded the fellowship of the AASLD. He is also an active member of AGA, EASL, IASL, APASL, PSSLD, and PSG. He is also the member of the prestigious New York Academy of Sciences and Fellow of the Royal Society of Tropical Medicine and Hygiene. He has been member and chair of several national and international conferences in various capacities and has been a guest faculty to several national and international meetings as a speaker /chair/moderator. His research work has been presented at the AASLD, EASL, APASL, AGA, and many other meetings in poster or oral presentations. At the national level, Prof. Jafri had been the General Secretary for Pakistan Society of Gastroenterology, Vice President of Pakistan Society of Hepatology, and Founding President of Pakistan Society for the Study of Liver and is currently the Patron of that Society. At the APASL he had been the part of the executive committee and is

currently on its advisory panel. His name has appeared in almost all the important guidelines of APASL which include Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, HCC, Variceal bleed , portal hypertension and liver fibrosis. He has also been part of WHO 2014 guidelines on chronic hepatitis C. He has also contributed to the national guidelines for hepatitis B and C in Pakistan. He was assistant editor of Hepatology International and is currently an editorial board member of this journal. Currently he is an editorial board member of liver International, World Journal of Gastroenterology, Translational Gastroenterology, Annals of Gastroenterology and Hepatology, Journal of Clinical and Experimental Gastroenterology, Dataset Papers in Medicine, Austin Journal of Hepatology, Pakistan Journal of Gastroenterology, Journal of Microbial and Biochemical Technology, Guest Editor of Hepatitis Research and Treatment, Academic editor of Clinical and translational Hepatology, Journal of Dow University of Health Sciences, Journal of Liaquat University of Health Science, Guest editor of International Journal of Hepatology and many more. In Pakistan Prof. Jafri has trained scores of physicians in the field of Gastroenterology and Hepatology who themselves are now professors and heads of departments at various institutions and training others. His research, education and training has made significant contributions in the health sector of the country. The whole country is indebted to him for having trained scores of Physicians as gastroenterologists who are now heading various institutions at national level imparting quality training and education this would regarded has his most significant contribution towards the health sector. As the founding Chair and associate dean of the department of continuing professional education he has made CME and lifelong learning mandatory for physicians of this country as at the Aga Khan University it is mandatory to have at least 50 credit hours annually for maintenance of credentialing. At the national level the Pakistan Medical and Dental council has also made this obligatory for maintenance of the license to practice medicine.
